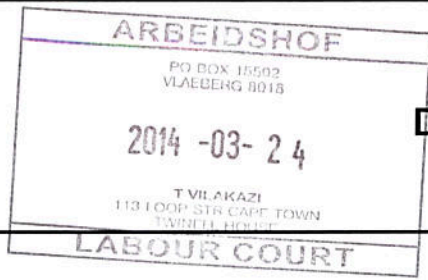

HAVING HEARD THE LEGAL REPRESENTATIVES OF THE RESPECTIVE PARTIES, THE FOLLOWING ORDER IS MADE BY AGREEMENT:

1. That First, Second and Third Respondents agree to suspend the boards of inquiry being held in terms of section 34(1)(l) of the South African Police Act, Act 68 of 1995.
2. In light of the agreement in paragraph (1) above, the Respondents agree not to issue any further section 34(1)(l) notices to employees of the South African Police Service who have been identified in the audit referred to in this application.
3. The agreement referred to in paragraphs (1) and (2) above, shall serve as an interim interdict pending the finalisation of the review process referred to in Part B of the Notice of Motion.
4. The Respondents shall file the documents referred to in the notice of motion for purposes of the review proceedings within 10 court days of this order.
5. Costs to be costs in the cause.
